APPLICATIONS RECEIVED

4. There were submitted for consideration the undernoted applications (circulated) which were determined as follows:-

- 4.1 MT 02/21 - Netherthird Community Development Group - Refused on the grounds of the limited budget available and to recommend that the group apply to the Renewable Energy Fund (Harehill) for full project costs;
- 4.2 MT 06/21 - Bonnie Doon Lodge - £10,000 to support the cost of either repairing or replacing the hall roof subject to receipt of an amended quote should a lower cost roof repair become the preferred option;
- 4.3 MT 07/21 - Lugar Bowling Club - £5,000 to support the cost of replacement window and roughcasting work, subject to the club agreeing to amend the dissolution clause in their Constitution so that members would not directly benefit should the club be wound up and the premises sold;

- 4.7 MT 15/21 - Lugar, Logan and Cronberry Community Council - £8,500, subject to written approval from the landowner for removal and replacement of lamp and written confirmation that full project funding had been secured;
- 4.8 MT 16/21 - Dalrymple Bowling Club - Refused on the grounds of the limited budget available and to recommend that the group apply to the Renewable Energy Fund (Original Whitelee) for funding;
- 4.9 MT 18/21 - Cumnock Action Plan - Refused on the grounds of the limited budget available and to recommend that the group apply to the Renewable Energy Fund (Harehill) for funding;
- 4.10 MT 04/21 - EPIC East Ayrshire Pipe Band Academy - £912 and that the group should be advised to fundraise and the use of weekly fees should be considered to meet the additional hire costs and the cost of band camp;
- 4.11 MT 08/21 - Ochiltree Bowling Club - £5,000; and
- 4.12 MT 17/21 - Auchinleck Community Development Initiative (ACDI) - £1,000, subject to confirmation that the event can be safely delivered within Government guidelines.
